Don't be intimidated, our members possess flying skill levels from beginner to advanced, range in age from 8 to 80 and have been in the hobby from months to decades, or returned after a 'minor' hiatus called life.



From the very first visit, you will make at least one new friend who will be glad to help you learn about remote control airplanes, our Club, field and facilities.



The Jetero R/C club owns 50 acres of flying field with 50 acres of overfly with a 600' x 100' grass runway. A very long covered pit area contains large tables, chairs, full kitchen with running water, electricity and ovens to support events. We have two covered restrooms with toilets and sink (no porta-potties)!

With a field this large, we have the facilities to support a wide range of skilled, to unskilled (fun-fly) events in addition to the regular open flying throughout the year.

Here's a list of the events for 2013 that we will be hosting for our own members, local and intra/inter state hobbyists, guests and spectators.

**February** - Frozen Fickle Finger of Fate Fun Fly. Our first event of the year, battling cold temperatures, but getting people out flying
